## Marie Skłodowska Curie

\*\* 7. November 1867; † 4. Juli 1934

*She was the first woman to win a Nobel Prize, the first person and only woman to win twice*

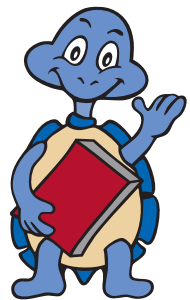
Leistungen

- As one of the most famous women scientists to date, Marie Curie has received tributes from across the globe and is the only woman to win a Nobel Prize in two different sciences
- With Henri Becquerel Curie decided to look into uranium rays as a possible field of research for a thesis, and form the word „radio-active“
- With husband Pierre Curie she discovers the elements radium and polonium
- She was the first woman who was teaching at the Sorbonne
- She procured X-ray equipment, vehicles, auxiliary generators, and developed mobile radiography units for field hospitals
- The curie (symbol Ci), a unit of radioactivity, is named in honour of her and Pierre Curie
