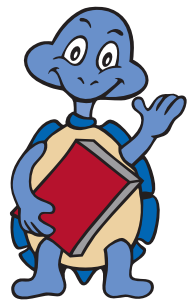

Experiencing immediate psychological abuse to her family from Hussein, Salbi chose to dedicate her adult life to the women around the world.

Performances

- Born in Iraq, she was the daughter of the personal pilot of Saddam Hussein. When she separated from her arranged marriage in the US, she needed to survive on her own in an unfamiliar country
- Together with her 2nd husband, she learned about the atrocities occurring in the Bosnian war. They founded „Women for Women“ to give hope and help for those trapped in rape camps and female war-survivors in general
- She wrote and spoke on the use of violence against women during war and was featured in major media outlets.
- In 1995, she was honored by President Bill for her humanitarian work in Bosnia
- She founded Nida's Show, the Zainab Salbi Project and is Editor At Large at Women in the World of The New York Times
